



Wildebeest fact file

Scientific name: Connochaetes (flowing beard) taurinus (like a bull) albojubatus (white mane)

Other name: Gnu

Size: males 50-58 inches at shoulder; females 46-57 inches at shoulder

Weight: adult males 165 to 274 kg; adult females 140 to 230 kg

Life span: up to 20 years in zoos

Sexual maturity: females around 2.5 years; males at 3 to 4 years

Habitat: grasslands of Eastern Africa

Diet: Wildebeest are Herbivores feeding mainly on grass.

The Circle of Life:

A Wildebeest's life revolves around their endless search of food and water. They migrate from one area to another in overwhelming herds looking for greener pastures. Zebra who share a similar diet to the Wildebeest, join them & follow the Wildebeests' migratory routes in search of food. Also, following this migration is a trail of predators such as Lion & Hyena who make these Herbivores their diet for as long as they are within their region. Atleast 1.5 million Wildebeest and some 200,000 Zebra are thought to be part of each year's migration.

Their journey begins in Tanzania around December, where they feed on the green grass produced after the rainy season in the Southern regions of the Serengeti National Reserve & the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. This is also their calving season, which lasts upto Mid March. By April, the great herds having exhausted the region's grassland move onward to the Western Serengeti Corridor which has produced greener grass due to it's ongoing rains. They feed on the Western Serengeti plains until June, once again leaving the exhausted region in search of food & moving northwards towards Kenya, entering the Masai Mara Game Reserve.

The Great Crossing:

By late July, the herds make their way across the Mara River infested with Crocodiles which lies as their final barrier to the great pastures ahead. They remain in the Masai Mara until mid/late October when the dry season approaches in Kenya and they start making their way back to the wet Southern plains of the Serengeti where they once again give birth, completing their migration and yet again embarking on the same journey for another year.

Ideal time to see the migration: Between late July & October in the Masai Mara, Kenya

HOT-AIR BALLOON SAFARIS

a very unique safari experience

For the adventure of a lifetime we offer the unique experience of a Balloon Safari over the plains, forest and river of the Masai Mara Game Reserve, famous for its abundance of wildlife throughout the year. Lions, Elephants, Buffalo, Hippos, Crocodiles and prolific numbers of plains game are regularly seen, as are the countless species of Birds both in flight and atop their lofty perches in the trees. The annual migration of the Wildebeest from July to October is a sight that, viewed from the vantage point of a Balloon is never to be forgotten.

Take off is shortly after sunrise. The flight lasts about an hour, with ample opportunities for photography and video filming from this unusual and often exciting perspective. After landing there is a traditional champagne toast, followed by a breakfast cooked on the Balloon burners in the middle of the rolling plains of the Masai Mara. It is another tradition with us that each passenger is presented with a certificate signed by the pilot to commemorate the flight. The Balloon Safari ends with a leisurely game drive which often allows you to return to the animals seen from the air before our vehicles return you to your camp.

There are no special requirements for participation in a Balloon Safari, you should be in good health condition, and reasonably fit & active. Children under 10 years cannot participate in the safari.

LAKE VICTORIA FISHING SAFARI

fishing in the heart of Africa



The lovely Lake Victoria is the setting for a holiday that's about as far away from it all as you can possibly get. It's the world's second largest freshwater lake and is the magical source of the Nile. A century ago European explorers risked their lives to claim this prize for their Empires. It was famed as the pearl of Africa. The Lake is rich in fish and birdlife, it's islands lush and verdant. The chance to catch the giant Nile perch draws many. Some come for the abundant birds, fish eagles, kingfishers and pelicans, others to glimpse the playful otters. A place to soothe the mind, to treat yourself to fish caught fresh that day, to fruit and vegetables from the lakeside gardens. Each morning fleets of brightly-painted fishing boats glide past, each evening their lights shimmer across the water. Day trips are possible from the Masai Mara Game Reserve using a light aircraft on a 40 minute flight, but we recommend staying for at least two nights, if only for the spectacular sunsets, the sky aflame as the sun sinks beneath the Lake.






BEST OF KENYA SAFARI

Day 01: Depart USA

Board your flight for Kenya & depart from USA.



Arrive at the Airport in Nairobi and meet our representative. Transfer to the Norfolk Hotel, a most luxurious & historical hotel set in the city with glorious courtyards reminiscing the era of the early settlers. The perfect start to what will truly be an Out Of Africa experience! Overnight at the Norfolk.

Day 03: Aberdare National Park

After breakfast, depart by air for Nanyuki & transfer to the elegant Aberdare Country Club, set in lush gardens roaming with Peacock. Arrive for a mouth-watering buffet lunch. In the afternoon, board the Club's vehicles to transfer to the Aberdare National Park for a night full of game viewing. Check in at the Ark, which is a Tree lodge uniquely designed to resemble Noah's Ark with observation rooms overlooking a waterhole frequented by the Big Game.

Day 04: Sweetwater's Game Reserve

An early breakfast at The Ark follows a transfer to Sweetwaters Game Reserve, host to all of the Big Five and many more species of Kenya's wildlife & birdlife. Afternoon game drives through the reserve bring you to the Sweetwaters Chimpanzee sanctuary for a boat ride & an introduction to the young orphaned chimps, followed by a visit to see Kenya's popular tame rhino – Morani. After dinner, retire to your luxurious en suite tent if you are exhausted by the previous night's game viewing – or if you're still active you could simply sit with a drink in your Tent's private balcony overlooking a waterhole & saltlick visited by Giraffe, Rhino & several antelope.

Day 05: Sweetwater's Game Reserve

Early morning game drive to watch the entire reserve come to life. Day at leisure for you to relax by the pool. In the evening, a night game drive brings you the chance to see the more nocturnal species of Africa's wildlife, such as Leopard.

Day 06: Nanyuki, Mount Kenya Region

A short drive out of Sweetwater's brings you to the legendary Mount Kenya Safari Club set against the backdrop of the magnificent Mt. Kenya. The Club, frequented by Royals & VIPs from around the world, features perfect lawns with pretty swans in little ponds and a large golf course. 

Day 07: Masai Mara Game Reserve Fly out to the Masai Mara - one of the world's best wildlife reserves, stretching out to the South and joining with

Tanzania's Serengeti ecosystem. Check in at the luxurious Kichwa Tembo Tented Camp set in a monkey-rich forest overlooking the Oloololo escarpment. An afternoon game drive in Open Landrover safari vehicles gives you a taste of pure African wilderness, as you search the plains for the famous Big Five and encounter several species of birds. The expert guide will enlighten you on the animal's characteristics and their habitat during your game viewing, and will also be available to answer your questions during & after the game drive. Return to the camp for dinner & spend

the night in true safari tradition around the Campfire with a drink recollecting your memories of the day's game viewing.

Day 08 & 09: Masai Mara Game Reserve

Early morning game drives give you the chance to see Africa's beautiful sunrise and watch the Mara come to life as the animals awaken filling the silence with mesmerising sounds. Afternoon game drives are also conducted daily, one of which will feature a visit to a Massai Cultural Village. With over 400 species, birdlife in Mara is prolific, and the camp grounds & game drives provide ample opportunities for bird watching. Along with the bird checklist available in your room, naturalists are always on hand to answer your questions. Talks on Maasai culture are conducted in the Camp grounds by a resident Maasai naturalist. And on alternate evenings a Maasai theme night gives you the chance to buy fascinating, colorful Maasai jewellery & ornaments.


Day 10: Nairobi

Return to Nairobi for a farewell lunch at the Carnivore, Africa's most popular game-meat restaurant. A day room at the Norfolk Hotel allows you to freshen up & pack before your flight out to the USA.









Day 03 & 04: Amboseli National Park

After an early breakfast, fly out to Amboseli, located in Southern Kenya close to the Kenya/Tanzania border. Check in at the Tortilis Camp, one of the best tented camps in East Africa renowned for it's delicious homestyle cuisine, high standards of service and stunning views of Mount Kilimanjaro, Africa's tallest mountain towering at 5895 metres. Morning and afternoon game drives give you a chance to view Amboseli National Park's astounding Elephant population [which ranges in thousands] among other wildlife such as Black Rhino, Lion, Leopard, Cheetah, Maasai Giraffe, Gazelle & Buffalo, to name a few. Amboseli is a birdwatcher's heaven with 300 hundred species on display.

Day 05 & 06: Samburu Game Reserve

Depart by air for Samburu, located in the Semi-arid Northern province, & check in at the beautiful Samburu Serena Lodge overlooking the Uaso Nyiro River. Game viewing in the morning and evening through the reserve offers a chance to see the wild beauty of the Samburu terrain & rare wildlife species such as the Reticulated Giraffe, Long-necked Gerenuk, Beisa Oryx & Grevy's Zebra. On a clear day, it is possible to see Mount Kenya, the highest mountain in the country from the Samburu game reserve. Birdlife in Samburu is prolific. Daily tribal dance performances by the Samburu warriors provide a pleasant end to each day.

Day 07, 08 & 09: Masai Mara Game Reserve

Fly across the Kenyan Rift Valley to the magical Masai Mara Game reserve & check in at Kichwa Tembo, for another chance to stay in an authentic safari luxury tented camp. The camp offers a spectacular view of the surrounding landscape, birdlife & game. During the annual wildebeest migration between July & October, the camp is in an ideal location from which to set out to see the millions of herbivores invading the lush green plains of the Mara. Game drives in the Mara in open-top safari vehicles are an unforgettable experience as you watch, unobstructed, the game filled plains unfold before you.

Visits to the Mara River offer a chance to see hippo & croc's sunning themselves on the banks. Cultural visits to Masai Village provide a fascinating insight on the local Maasai lifestyle. Masai Mara is a birdwatchers delight with over 400 species and a bird checklist thoughtfully placed in each tent.

Day 10: Nairobi

Set off for Nairobi and stop for lunch at Carnivore, Kenya's famous game meat restaurant. Check in at the Norfolk for day use and later transfer for your flight back home with wonderful memories of Kenya & it's splendid wildlife & landscape.

All this, combined with it's luxurious long stretches of white sandy beaches along the Spice coast of Zanzibar [often considered to possess among the best beaches in the world], Tanzania offers the ultimate African Beach & Bush experiences.

After an early breakfast, fly out to Lake Manyara National Park & check in at the Lake Manyara Serena Lodge offering dramatic views of the Rift Valley. Lunch followed by an afternoon game drive for a chance to see the famous Lake Manyara & the Pink Flamingo. The park is also rich in other wildlife such as Lion, Elephant, Crocodile, Hippo & Coke's hartbeest.

Day 04 & 05: Ngorongoro Crater Conservancy

Depart early in the morning for a five hour drive to the Ngorongoro Crater and check in at the Ngorongoro Serena Lodge. A full day crater tour with an elegant picnic lunch is the traditional way of exploring the crater.

Day 06, 07 & 08: Serengeti Game Reserve

Check out from the lodge early and depart for a full day game drive with picnic lunch en route to Serengeti. Stop at the Ol Duvai Gorge, where fossils of early man were unearthed. Arrive at the Serengeti Serena Lodge in the late afternoon. The lodge is designed like a traditional Maasai Village, and accommodation is in luxurious rondavel huts offering breathtaking views of the Serengeti plains below. Two daily game drives are conducted with professional guides through the open plains bursting with wildlife. Evenings at the lodge are filled with traditional Maasai dance performances.

Day 09: Arusha

Check out & depart by air for Arusha. A day room at the Novotel allows you freshen up before your return flight to the USA.



Day 02: Arusha

Upon arrival at Arusha International airport, meet our representative and transfer to the luxurious Novotel Mt. Meru Hotel. An overnight in Arusha is necessary during your safari to connect with local flights to your next destination.

Day 03: Lake Manyara National Park

After an early breakfast, fly out to Lake Manyara National Park and check in at the magnificent Lake Manyara Tree Lodge, newly constructed in place of Maji Moto Tented Camp. Lunch followed by your first game drive in Tanzania. Lake Manyara National Park, made famous after Dr. Iain Douglas Hamilton's research book 'Among the Elephants', offers some of the best bird watching in East Africa including the Pink Flamingo.

Day 04 & 05: Ngorongoro Crater Conservancy

Depart early in the morning for a five hour drive to the Ngorongoro Crater Conservancy and check in at the Ngorongoro Crater Lodge - which can only be described as one of the best safari lodges in the world. Nearly 3 million years ago, Ngorongoro once stood as a large Volcano believed to be bigger than Mount Kilimanjaro, which erupted forming the World's largest & most spectacular caldera. Ngorongoro Crater houses approximately 30,000 wild animals and over 40,000 Maasai people living together in harmony. A full day crater tour with an elegant picnic lunch is the traditional way of exploring the crater.



Grumeti is a private game reserve located in the Western corridor of the Serengeti, on the banks of the Grumeti River, home to several hippo & crocs. Morning and afternoon game drives in the savannah woodlands are conducted in Open Landrover vehicles with professional guides through the open Serengeti plains bursting with great concentrations of wildlife. Guided bush walks give you a closer look at the African wilderness. The Serengeti region boasts some of the largest concentrations of Cheetah, Lion and Leopard in Africa.

Day 09: Arusha



TREKKING MT. KILIMANJARO;

Mount Kilimanjaro is Africa's highest & the World's second highest mountain, towering at 5895m and located in North Eastern Tanzania, along the Kenya/Tanzania border. There are several routes to climb Mount Kilimanjaro however the most popular & easiest of these is the Marangu route.

While there is no serious climbing & schedule, trails & accommodation are designed to allow visitors to acclimatize comfortably, please note that participants should be fit & able to walk over long distances. Altitude sickness [which is common] may be experienced during the trek.

Day 01: Depart USA Board your flight for Tanzania.

Day 02: Arusha Upon arrival in Arusha, transfer to your hotel for overnight.

Day 03: Mandara Hut [2745m]
Begin your climb through the bird & wildlife rich rainforests. After approximately 3 hours arrive at the Mandara Hut for your overnight.

Day 04: Horombo Hut [3760m] Walk through the Alpine meadows & moorlands for 7 hours. Arrive at the Horombo Hut for overnight.

Day 05: Kibo Hut [4730m] Continue across the high altitude desert and further on between between Kibo & Mawenzi for 7 hours, arriving at the Kibo Hut for your overnight.

Day 06: Uhuru Peak [highest point - 5895m] The final 7-hour ascent up the steep slopes begins at 0100hrs, reaching the Gillman's point at dawn. Continue along the Gillman's Peak crater rim to Uhuru Peak where you see the beautiful views of the plains below. Return to Horombo Hut for overnight.

Day 07: Arusha Descend to the Marangu Gate and transfer to Arusha for overnight at a hotel.

Day 08: Depart Arusha Board your return flight to the USA.
